ARRL Field Day 2019

ARRL Field Day 2019 is less than 3 months away! Field Day is always the fourth full weekend of June, beginning at 1800 UTC (11:00am AZ) Saturday, June 22nd, and running through 2059 UTC (1:59pm AZ) Sunday, June 23rd. The Field Day website already has updated content for 2019, and more is planned. While there are no substantial changes from prior years, some website text has been updated and clarified. With appropriate software versions and proper setup, the Field Day exchange can now occur using FT8.
