

# Enter your Postcard Password

**Note! This applies only to USA licensees!**

1. Go to the Postcard Password Entry webpage:  
<https://p1k.arrl.org/lotw/password>
2. Enter your callsign in the callsign box and enter the password exactly as it is on the card in the password box. The password is eight alpha-numeric characters above the address and batch numbers on the front of your postcard. The password is case sensitive.
3. Click SUBMIT PASSWORD

You will receive your certificate (TQ6 file) as an e-mail attachment within three business days. **This e-mail will also contain your password to log onto the LoTW users page and access your account. Your Log-on ID is your callsign. You can/should change this password after you log-on.**
