

## How To Configure **N3FJP AC Log** To Upload Logs To Logbook of The World

- N3FJP AC Log is a popular logging program.
- One of the features of AC Log is the ability to upload QSOs directly to your Logbook of The World account.

- This tutorial will enable you to enter the required information to take advantage of this feature.
- N3FJP AC Log is <u>NOT</u> an ARRL program therefore we can not offer any support for this software package.

- 1. Open the N3FJP ACLog program.
- 2. Select the LoTW button.



On the left side of the form enter the LoTW account username and password.

The information for USERNAME and PASSWORD are in the body of the e-mail which contained your TQ6 file.

Please note that this is NOT the postcard password or the private key password that you created when requesting a certificate.



Now enter the TQSL station location.

Note that the selected station location name is shown in gray at the lower portion of the TQSL form. The station location name is case sensitive.

In this example the station location is N1ZQ Hartford. The station location is <u>NOT N1ZQ-N1ZQ Hartford</u>.

The station location must match exactly as you entered it when you created the station location in TQSL. (see <u>www.arrl.org/instructions</u> for information on how to create a station location in TQSL.)

#### Enter your call sign in the box "Own Call."



Verify that the path to Trusted QSL is correct.

The default path is C:\program files\TrustedQSL.

For Windows 7 and Vista 64 the default path is C:\program files (x86)\TrustedQSL.
