**Purpose.** The ARES Group Identification Form provides ARRL headquarters with basic information regarding the ARES groups

**Preparation.** This form is primarily prepared by the EC or in some cases the DEC.

1.	Date	Enter today's date. Use this format (mm/dd/yyyy)
2.	Section	Your Section name (e.g. NC, WMA, NTX, AZ)
3.	County	Enter name of your County, Parish, Administrative Region
4.	Name of ARES Group	Enter the name of your ARES group
5.	Call Sign	If your ARES group has a call sign enter it here
6.	Coverage Area	Select from the drop-down list the area covered by your group
7.	Description of Area	Select from the drop-down list what best describes the type of area covered
8.	Year ARES group established	If you know the year the ARES group was formed enter it here
9.	Is your ARES Group a 501(c)(3)	Choose Yes or No if your group is incorporated
10.	Facebook Page	If you have a Facebook page enter the link here
11.	Twitter Link	If your group has a Twitter link enter it here
12.	Instagram Link	If your group has an Instagram link enter it here
