
3. Select the tab YOUR CERTIFICATES.



4. Verify that you have a valid certificate issued to you.

* Note: You **cannot** download your certificate from the user page.

The file that is downloadable from this page is the same TQ6 file that is sent via e-mail. The option to download the TQ6 from the web is for users who cannot receive e-mail attachments.



5. Verify that the QSOs that you want to upload are within the range of QSO dates of your certificate.
