Dear Mr. Garner:

On November 22, 2005, agents from the Atlanta Office investigated an interference complaint from Mr. Paul Fulk concerning power line noise affecting radio communications at his residence at 3749 Clarity Road, Springfield, TN. The agents determined that there was excessive power line noise radiating from at least two locations in the Timberlake Subdivision. Specifically, the agents found that the utility pole located between 403 and 405 Timberlake Drive and the pole located on the corner of Deerfield Drive and Hunters Lane were both radiating radio frequency energy between 47 MHz and 121 MHz. Both instances of power line noise were sufficient to cause interference to radio communications to nearby residents.

Section 15.5(b) of the Rules states that "Operation of an intentional, unintentional, or incidental radiator is subject to the conditions that no harmful interference is caused." Section 15.5(c) of the Rules requires that "The operator of the radio frequency device shall be required to cease operating the device upon notification by a Commission representative that the device is causing harmful interference."
