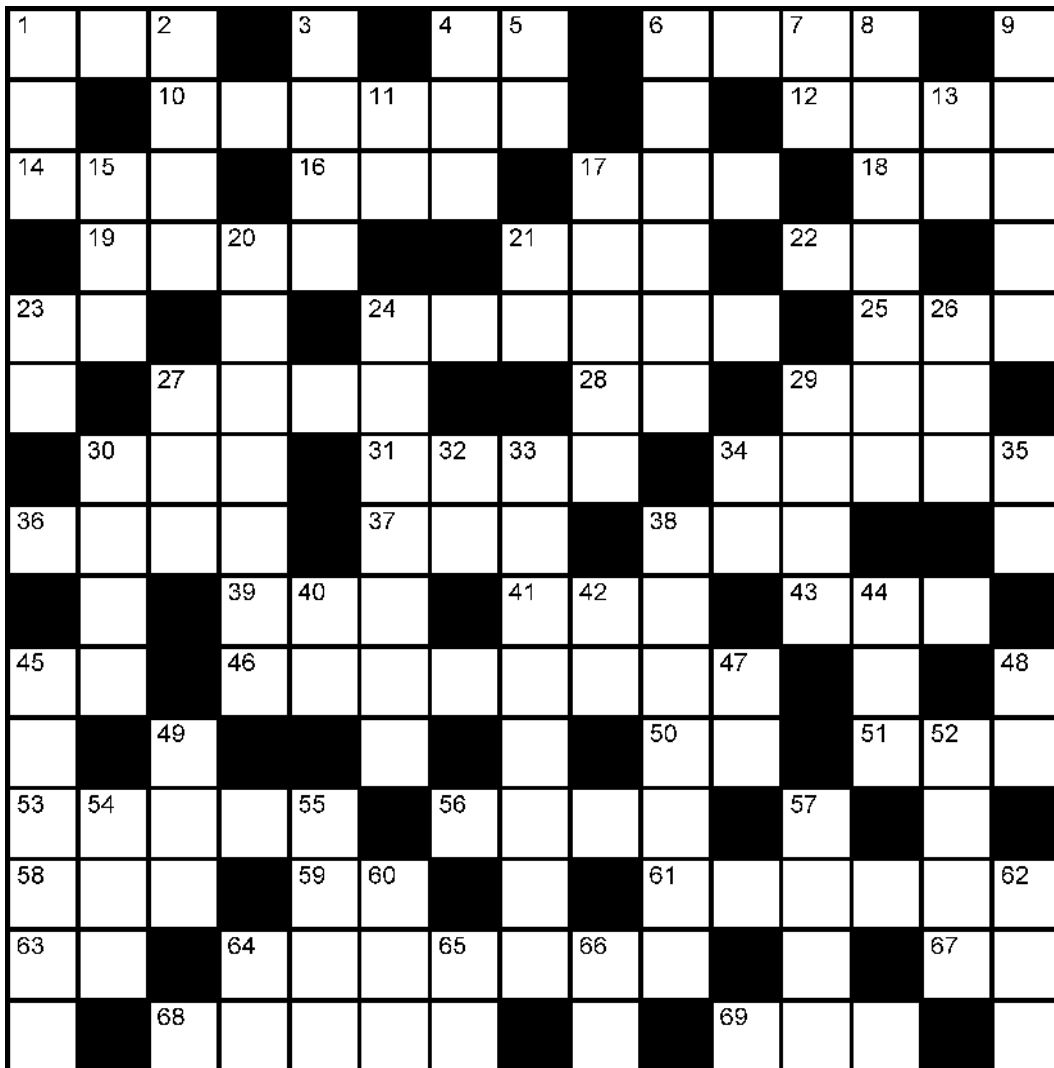


Amateur Radio Crossword Puzzler
